In the absence of suitably qualified employees of the Ministry, by selection from among candidates who possess the above qualifications.


Candidates should produce written evidence of experience claimed.

- Duties:**
1. To clean the laboratory, benches, floors, glassware and other apparatus using special reagents including those which may involve the use of special cleaning reagents.
 2. To be responsible for the first steps in almost all analyses.
 3. To sterilise glasswares and culture media.
 4. To help in the bleeding of laboratory animals and in the preparation of culture media and various solutions.
 5. To receive, sort out and record specimens and channel them to sections concerned.
 6. To destroy all infectious materials after analyses.
 7. To keep all apparatus in good working condition.
