Ministry: Health and Quality of Life

Post: Pool Attendant (Hydrotherapy Unit)

Salary: Rs 8,800 x 200 – 10,200 x 250 – 11,700 x 300 – 13,800 (24 14 34)

Effective Date: 25 August 2011

Qualifications: By selection from among employees in the grade of Hospital Care Attendant (on shift) on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Ministry who reckon at least three years' service in the grade.

Experience in handling of patients for hydrotherapy care is desirable.

Duties:

1. To open and close the Hydrotherapy Unit.
2. To clean and maintain the pool, showers, toilets and accessories.
3. To regularly monitor the pH of pool water and level of chlorine.
4. To daily siphon off dirt and vacuum clean the pool flooring and walls.
5. To regularly backwash the pool filter.
6. To collect pool water specimen weekly and despatch it to the Bacteriology Department for analysis.
7. To monitor and ensure proper storage of pool chemicals and other accessories.
8. To daily monitor the pool water temperature.
9. To regularly clean the pool accessories, such as filter and pump, etc., and heater of the Hydrotherapy Unit.
10. To assist physiotherapy personnel in handling difficult and obese patients in and out of the pool.
11. To wheel-chair patients to the Hydrotherapy Unit.
12. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Pool Attendant (Hydrotherapy Unit) in the roles ascribed to him.
