On successful completion of the training and on obtention of the National Certificate Level 5 in Community-Based Rehabilitation, they will be considered for appointment as Community Health Rehabilitation Officer in a substantive capacity, as and when vacancies occur.

Duties:

- (g) to organise recreational and occupational activities for the disabled in the Community; and
- (h) to provide on-the-job training for new recruits.
- 2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Community Health Rehabilitation Officer in the roles ascribed to him.
