Qualifications: By selection from among candidates who –

- A. possess the Certificate of Primary Education;
- B. show proof of having sat for the Cambridge School Certificate Examination or the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” Examination in at least five subjects at one sitting or an examination of equivalent standard acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- C. reckon at least two years’ experience in community-based activities.

Candidates should produce written evidence of experience claimed.

Duties:

- 1. To motivate the community to improve the quality of life and lifestyle.
- 2. To undertake home/site visits in order to promote family planning methods and distribute family planning pills and condoms.
- 3. To sensitise women/girls for early detection for breast/cervical cancer.
- 4. To distribute pamphlets and educational materials related to health issues.
- 5. To effect site visits prior to holding of Non-Communicable Diseases and health promotion activities.
- 6. To sensitise the community on the control of Communicable Diseases.
- 7. To trace drop-outs from health programmes.
- 8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Field Health Worker in the roles ascribed to him.
