- Qualifications:** A. Cambridge School Certificate with credit in English Language, French and either Biology or Human and Social Biology or Chemistry or Physics obtained on one certificate or Passes not below Grade C in English Language, French and either Biology or Human and Social Biology or Chemistry or Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. Candidates should be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

- Duties:**
 1. To visit households, incoming passengers, schools, health institutions and other places in his area as directed by the Regional Public Health Superintendent, Health Inspectorate Cadre, the Principal Health Surveillance Officer or the Senior Health Surveillance Officer, and obtain any necessary information, as required, and to keep all relevant records.
 2. To take blood smears and collect specimens, where indicated.
 3. To report any public health nuisance he may come across during his visits.

4. To exercise control over the Insecticide Sprayermen working under his supervision and over the stores issued to him.
5. To keep daily record of work.
6. To supervise the proper working of spraying apparatuses, the proper mixing of insecticides and the spraying techniques of the Insecticide Sprayermen.
7. To ensure that all necessary precautions are taken when using or handling different kinds of insecticides.
8. To visit households and obtain permission for the spraying of their premises.
9. To perform duties including field duties in connection with vectors of medical importance in Mauritius and Outer Islands.
10. To collect in the field and identify vectors of medical importance, to catch mosquitoes and other vectors at night, to flit habitations and other premises for the collection of vectors.
11. To assist in the implementation of Environmental Health Education Programmes.
12. To carry out mapping of their respective sectors.
13. To carry out numbering of dwellings and sectors, etc.
14. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
15. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Health Surveillance Officers in the roles ascribed to them.
