**Post:** Tradesman's Assistant

**Effective Date:** 15 June 2005

**Qualifications:** By selection from among General Workers on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Department who possess the Certificate of Primary Education.

**Note 1**

In the absence of candidates possessing the Certificate of Primary Education, consideration will be given to candidates who show proof of being literate.

**Note 2**

Tradesman's Assistants will be required to pass the appropriate trade test to be eligible for appointment as Tradesman.

**Duties:**

1. To work under the supervision of and to assist the Maintenance Assistant/Tradesman.
2. To be familiar with the tools of the trade and to use them to perform operations, as appropriate, under the guidance of the Maintenance Assistant/Tradesman so as to develop gradually the skills necessary for the trade.
3. To ensure, under the guidance of the Maintenance Assistant/Tradesman, that all tools, equipment and accessories used in the trade are kept in good working order.
4. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.
