4. To carry out repairs and adjustments to carburettors, fuel injection systems, clutches, gear boxes, couplings, front and rear axles, differentials, brakes, steering systems, suspensions etc..
5. To carry out the necessary measurements and calculations on vehicles and plants.
6. To produce simple parts involving fitting, soldering and welding.
