- Qualifications:**
- A. A Certificate of Competency as Able Bodied Seaman from a recognised body/institution.
 - B. A valid certificate issued under the provisions of the Standard of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers Convention as amended (Reg. II/4).
 - C. At least three years' experience as Able Bodied Seaman on foreign-going vessels.
 - D. A good command of maritime English including maritime terminology.
- Duties:**
- 1. To prepare, under supervision, nautical equipment required for the training of Seamen.
 - 2. To exercise control on such stores as liferaft, wires, ropes, rowing oars for the training of seafarers.
 - 3. To perform maintenance on fixed nautical equipment such as derricks, flagstaff, cargo hatches and lifeboats.
 - 4. To be responsible for recording of attendance of trainees and report to the Head, Deck Department and the Principal, Sea Training School.
 - 5. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.
