- Qualifications:
- (1) A Cambridge School Certificate, or a London General Certificate of Education ('O' Level) with passes in five subjects including English Language on one certificate.
 - (2) A good physique with the following minimum physical requirements:-
 - (i) Height 1m 67.5 cms
 - (ii) Chest 84 cms (normal inspiration).
 - (3) Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years of age.
 - (4) Satisfactory knowledge of music and ability to play string and wind musical instruments.

In the absence of candidates with the qualifications at (1) above, consideration will be given to candidates who show proof of having sat for the Cambridge School Certificate or the London or Cambridge General Certificate of Education ('O' Level) in five subjects including English Language.

Conditions on Enlistment:

- (a) Candidates will be enlisted initially as Trainees and will be required to follow a two-year training course in theoretical and practical music and in all aspects of the work of a bandsman. They will be considered for appointment as bandsman on the successful completion of the training course and as and when vacancies occur.
- (b) Candidates who are married at the time of enlistment will enjoy the privileges accruing to married members of the Police Force only after they have completed three years' service as Bandsman.
