In case they are found medically unfit or do not reach the required standard in the aptitude test for flying, their enlistment as Cadet Officer will be terminated forthwith.

Training:

Selected candidates will be required to undergo training in their appropriate fields which may include programmes locally or abroad for a period of at least two years, as approved and arranged by the Police Department, leading to an appropriate certificate or licence, where applicable.

On successful completion of such training and on obtention of the appropriate certificate or licence, where applicable, Cadet Officers will be eligible for appointment to the grade of Deputy Assistant Superintendent of Police or Woman Police Deputy Assistant Superintendent, as and when vacancies occur.
