**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 16 OF THE
DISCIPLINED FORCES SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Department:** Police
- Post:** Cadet Officer (Others)
- Salary:** Rs 20,525 x 475 – 21,950 x 625 – 23,200 x 775 – 26,300 (14 046 055)
- Age Limit:** Not less than 22 years of age and not more than 30 years of age for unit **A I** and not more than 35 years of age for unit **A II**.
- Effective Date:** 19 July 2017
- Qualifications:** By selection from among members of the Police Force who –

A. I. For the National Coast Guard

(a) Flying Branch

- (i) possess a Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at “Principal Level” in Mathematics and Physics or passes in at least two subjects including Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”;
- (ii) hold a Pilot Licence from an ICAO contracting State with at least 200 hours of flying experience; and
- (iii) have 6/6 eyesight in both eyes without glasses or contact lenses.

(b) Executive Branch

- (i) possess a Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at “Principal Level” in Mathematics and Physics or passes in at least two subjects including Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”; and
- (ii) have 6/6 eyesight in both eyes without glasses or contact lenses.

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*for Senior Chief Executive
Ministry of Civil Service and
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II. For the Police Band

- (i) possess a Cambridge Higher School Certificate or passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”; and
- (ii) hold a diploma from the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (DIP ABRSM)

OR

Equivalent qualifications to the above acceptable to the Disciplined Forces Service Commission.

- B. possess good communication and interpersonal skills.

NOTE 1

In the absence of qualified serving members of the Police Force, by selection from among candidates who –

- (i) possess the qualifications specified at A and B above;
- (ii) have a good physique and able to undergo strenuous physical exercise;
- (iii) have a normal eyesight (without glasses or contact lenses) except for units at **A I** where candidates should have 6/6 eyesight in both eyes without glasses or contact lenses;

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(iv) satisfy the following minimum physical requirements –

For male candidates

Height : 1 m 70 cm
Chest Measurement : 84 cm (normal inspiration)

For female candidates

Height : 1 m 63 cm

(v) are computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

NOTE 2

1. Selected candidates will be required to undergo appropriate medical tests to be arranged by the Police Department.
2. Candidates enlisted for the National Coast Guard (Flying Branch) will, within a period of three months of their date of enlistment, be required to undergo an examination so as to determine their medical fitness and aptitude for flying. In case they are found medically unfit or do not reach the required standard in the aptitude test for flying, their enlistment as Cadet Officer will be terminated forthwith.

Training:

Selected candidates will be required to undergo training which may include programmes locally or abroad for a period of at least two years, as approved and arranged by the Police Department, leading to an appropriate certificate or licence, where applicable.

On successful completion of such training and on obtention of the appropriate certificate or licence, where applicable, Cadet Officers will be eligible for appointment to the grade of Deputy Assistant Superintendent of Police or Woman Police Deputy Assistant Superintendent, as and when vacancies occur.



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
