Qualifications:

Should be able to assume the responsibilities of a higher post as third in command. Must be a potential Gazetted Officer. Must have a vast experience in Police work, an exemplary character and the confidence of the public. Appointment made from among inspectors on grounds of qualifications, experience, merit and suitability for the ranks of Chief Inspector and higher rank in the Force.

Duties:

Is the third in command of a district or branch. He is the liaison officer between his superior officers and the rank and file. He is also the Welfare Officer of his subordinates. He looks after drilling of the men and their discipline and prepares all the operation Orders for functions in his area. Is responsible for the state of arms and ammo, equipment and Government property and for the general cleanliness of their D.H.Q. or B.H.Q. Must be conversant with all orders and see that these are brought to the office of N.C.Os and men.
