Duties:

CIVIL SERV

- 1. To be responsible to the Commissioner of Police for:-
 - (i) the efficient management and functioning of the Police Medical Unit;
 - (iii) promoting the health care and looking after the medical welfare of all members of the Force:
 - (iii) organising and supervising the medical examination of all candidates for employment in the Force and ascertaining their ensuing fitness for service:
 - ensuring maintenance of medical records connected with the health of (iv) all Police Officers:
 - (v) exercising control and supervision over Police Medical staff and ensuring that Departmental Orders are complied with;
 - (vi) supervising the training of Trainee Police Medical Officers;
 - advising the Commissioner of Police on the formulation of health (vii) policies and programmes for the Force; and
 - (viii) organising and supervising all medico-legal examinations.
- 2. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

Note

The Chief Police Medical Officer may be required to be on call after normal working hours to cater for medical/medico-legal examinations.
