**Department:** Police

**Post:** Director-General, Anti Drug and Smuggling Unit

**Salary:** Rs 47,500 (14 00 82)

**Effective Date:** 22 October 2003

**Qualifications:** By selection from among members of the Mauritius Police Force not below the rank of Superintendent of Police who are proactive and are able to inspire confidence and trust.

Wide knowledge and proven experience of drug and crime intelligence work will be an advantage.

**Duties**

1. To be responsible to the Commissioner of Police for:-
  - (a) the good running and proper management of the Anti Drug and Smuggling Unit;
  - (b) commanding, organising and leading all staff working under his orders with a view to ensuring that appropriate and efficient measures are taken in the combat against drug trafficking and smuggling;
  - (c) planning and monitoring drug and crime intelligence operations (illegal betting, prostitution, racketeering, etc.) in consultation with other Divisional and Branch Officers of the Force;
  - (d) monitoring and coordinating projects with public and private agencies relating to drug trafficking and smuggling issues; and
  - (e) conducting drug and crime reduction awareness campaigns through mass media.
2. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.
