Candidates should:-

- (i) be fully registered as dental surgeon in accordance with legislation in force in Mauritius; and
- (ii) have at least three years' experience as a dental surgeon.

Knowledge and experience in the practice of Forensic Odontology is desirable.

Candidates should produce written evidence of all knowledge/experience claimed.

Duties:

- 1. To be responsible to the Commissioner of Police through the officer-in-charge of the Police Medical and Scientific Unit for the following duties:-
 - (i) to perform dental work;
 - (ii) to manage the Police dental clinic including stores, equipment and other related administrative responsibilities;
 - (iii) to carry out preventive and promotive activities including lectures related to oral health;
 - (iv) to carry out examination of cases of forensic importance (age estimation, identification in mass disasters, examination of bite marks, etc.) and give evidence in courts of law; and
 - (v) to attend to similar examination as at (iv) in Rodrigues and other Outer Islands.
- 2. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

The Police Dental Surgeon/Senior Police Dental Surgeon may be required to work outside normal working hours including Sundays and Public Holidays.
