Qualifications:

By promotion, on the basis of experience, merit and seniority, of Police Sergeants who:

- (a) reckon at least 10 years' satisfactory service in a substantive capacity in the grade;
- (b) are fully conversant with all aspects of police duties;
- (c) have good interpersonal and communication skills; and
- (d) have the ability to exercise authority.

Duties:

To be responsible to the Assistant Commissioner of Police/Woman Assistant Commissioner of Police through the Officer-in-Charge of the Station or Unit for -

- (i) assisting the Officer-in-Charge of the Station or Unit in the smooth running of the Station or Unit;
- (ii) replacing the Officer-in-Charge of the Station or Unit in the latter's absence; and
- (iii) performing such other duties as laid down under section 9(1), (2) and (3) of the Police Act or as directed by the Commissioner of Police.

<u>Note</u>

- Sub-Inspectors of Police will be required to work on shift, covering a 24-hour service including Sundays, Public Holidays and officially declared cyclone days.
- 2. They may be called upon to work for longer hours in cases of emergency, raids, parades, drills, etc.
