Qualifications:

A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained on one certificate or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

## NOTE

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

Experience in welfare work will be an advantage.

Candidates should produce written evidence of any experience claimed.

**Training:** 

Trainee Welfare Officers will be required to undergo on-the-job training in all aspects of the work of a Welfare Officer for a period of at least one year.

On successful completion of their training, Trainee Welfare Officers will be eligible for appointment to the grade of Welfare Officer as and when vacancies occur.

## NOTE

- 1. Trainee Welfare Officers will be required to follow the course leading to the Diploma in Social Work at a recognised institution as approved and arranged.
- 2. Trainee Welfare Officers should be prepared to work outside normal working hours including Sundays and Public Holidays.
