Qualifications:

- (i) Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings or
- Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or
- (iii) An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

B. Candidates should be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Training:

Trainee Library Clerks will be required to undergo on-the-job training for a period of at least one year and to follow a course leading to the Certificate in Library Studies and Information Science at a recognised institution.

On successful completion of the training, Trainee Library Clerks will be considered for appointment to the grade of Library Clerk, as and when vacancies occur.
