Qualifications: By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Survey Field Worker/Senior Survey Field Worker who reckon at least six years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade or an aggregate of at least six years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade of Survey Field Worker/Senior Survey Field Worker and the former grades of Poler and/or Chainman and who –

- (a) possess a basic knowledge of measures to be taken in cases of accidents and injury; and
- (b) have good communication, interpersonal and leadership skills.

Duties:

1. To be in charge of the maintenance of Trig Beacons.
2. To pole out long boundary lines, especially where contiguous to private properties.
3. To train Survey Field Workers/Senior Survey Field Workers in poling operations.
4. To be responsible for entries in the time books and log books for himself and his subordinates.
5. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Head Survey Field Worker in the roles ascribed to him.
