Qualifications: By selection from among General Workers, on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Ministry possessing the Certificate of Primary Education.

Note 1

In the absence of candidates possessing the Certificate of Primary Education, consideration will be given to candidates who show proof of being literate.

Note 2

Tradesman’s Assistants (Mason) will be required to pass the appropriate trade test to be eligible for appointment as Mason.

- Duties:**
1. To mix mortar and concrete, and to place them for structures under construction.
 2. To cut, bend and prepare reinforcements to be used in concrete structures.
 3. To prepare formworks for casting any concrete structures.
 4. To dig in soil and prepare hole for casting of bases to accommodate traffic signal/traffic sign posts.
 5. To dress stones or bricks for any purpose.
 6. To assist the Mason in -
 - (i) setting out foundations and setting levels and square angles accurately.
 - (ii) the installation of new traffic signal equipment on site, as and when instructed;
 - (iii) building coursed stone walls in correct bond;
 - (iv) building walls with the correct use of stone “libages/parpaings” and ensuring that the correct joints are made;
