- Qualifications:**
- A. Candidates should:
- (i) possess the Certificate of Primary Education; and
 - (ii) show proof of having sat for the Cambridge School Certificate Examination or the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” Examination in at least five subjects at one sitting or an examination of equivalent standard acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. Candidates should also possess:
- (i) a valid driving licence to drive motorcycle; and
 - (ii) the ability to plot and read graphs.
- Duties:**
1. To read and record water levels at storage reservoirs, dams, canal headwork, flow-measuring structures under both normal and flood conditions.
 2. To regulate and maintain flow releases from rivers, reservoirs and main reservoir feeders.
 3. To read and record rainfall and other climatological data.
 4. To operate water level recorders, rainfall recording gauges and other hydrological, hydrogeological and meteorological equipment.
 5. To assist Hydrological Technicians during current-metering exercises, pumping and airlift tests.
 6. To report any obstruction at and/or damage to any hydrometric, hydrogeological and meteorological stations.
