Ministry: Youth and Sports

Post: Senior Youth Officer

Salary: Rs 7,750 x 250 - 9,000 (WEL 14)

Effective Date: 27 June, 1994

Qualifications: By promotion on the basis of experience and merit of officers in the grade of Youth Officer reckoning at least four years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade.

Duties:

1. To be responsible for the day-to-day management of Youth Centres.
2. To co-ordinate the work of officers under his supervision.
3. To develop, plan, organise and co-ordinate activities at local level and liaise with youth and other organisations concerned in this connection.
4. To take charge of residential youth training centres and youth camps even for long periods.
5. To carry out the training of Youth Officers.
6. To assist in the organisation of residential and non-residential training courses, seminars, conferences and outdoor activities for the youth and to be physically present for the duration of the activities.
7. To carry out Youth surveys.
8. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

NOTE:

Senior Youth Officers should be prepared to work outside normal working hours, and on Sundays and Public Holidays.
