Road Safety March

As you are aware, Road Safety has become a major cause of concern nowadays and instilling a road safety culture amongst citizens has become one of the main priorities of Government. In the wake of the continued increase in traffic fatalities and injuries, the Ministry of Land Transport and Light Rail will be commemorating the World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims on 15 November 2020 which will be followed by a **Road Safety Week from 16 to 21 November 2020.**

During the Road Safety Week, the Ministry of Land Transport and Light Rail will organise a **“Road Safety March” on Wednesday 18 November 2020.** The March will start at 11.30 hours at Champ de Mars and will end at Le Jardin de la Compagnie. Hon. Alan Ganoo, Minister of Land Transport and Light Rail, and Hon. Teeruthraj Hurdoyal, Minister of Public Service, Administrative and Institutional Reforms, will participate in the March and will address the participants at the end of the March at Le Jardin de la Compagnie.
