#### Travelling and Car Benefits

The Pay Research Bureau has at paragraph 18.2.19 (No. 3) of its 2013 Report recommended that officers in posts drawing monthly salary in the range of **Rs 50100 and up to Rs 73200** would be eligible for 100% duty exemption for the purchase of a car with engine capacity of up to 1500 c.c. once every seven years.

2. The cut-off point for this privilege in the 2013 Errors, Omissions and Anomalies Committee Report (EOAC) is a monthly salary in the range of **Rs 54275 and up to Rs 77000**.

3. The Committee set up to look into the representations arising out of the 2013 EOAC Report recommended, inter alia, that the benefit of 100% duty exemption on a car of up to 1500 cc together with a monthly travelling allowance of Rs 10200 and loan facilities be restored **on a personal basis** to those officers who would have drawn a monthly salary of **Rs 50100 or more, on 01 January 2013 and 01 January 2014, with the 2013 PRB Report**.

4. The High Powered Committee has, at its meeting held on 03 August 2015, approved that those officers who would have been eligible for 100% duty exemption on **01 January 2015 with the 2013 PRB Report** be allowed to benefit from same along with other related benefits on a **personal basis**.

5. It would be appreciated if the contents of this Circular Note could be brought to the attention of eligible officers serving in your Ministry/Département and of Parastatal and other Statutory Bodies falling under the aegis of your respective Ministry.
