Payment of Travel Grant

The Pay Research Bureau has at paragraph 18.2.11 (ii) of its 2013 Report provided for the payment of a travel grant to officers having reached salary cut-off point of Rs 35400. However, the cut-off point for travel grant has been fixed at Rs 39275 in the Errors, Omissions and Anomalies Committee Report on the 2013 PRB Report.

2. Subsequently, the Committee, set up to look into representations arising out of the 2013 Errors, Omissions and Anomalies Committee (EOAC) Report, recommended that a monthly travel grant of Rs 6600 along with loan facilities to purchase a car be extended to officers who would have drawn a monthly salary of Rs 35400, or more, on 01 January 2014, with the PRB Report 2013.
3. The High Powered Committee has now, at its meeting held on 01 December 2014, approved a monthly travel grant of Rs 6600 along with loan facilities to purchase a car to eligible officers who would have drawn a monthly salary of Rs 35400 or more on 01 January 2015 with the PRB Report 2013.
