Travelling and Petrol Allowances

Following the increase in the price of petrol, road tax, and insurance premium for cars, it has been decided that the travelling and petrol allowances be revised with effect from 1 January 2003 as follows:

(a)	For officers drawing monthly <u>basic</u> salary of: Rs 50,000 and above Rs 38,750 and up to Rs 46,750 Rs 34,270 and up to Rs 37,500	Rs 7,225 Rs 5,000 Rs 3,800
(b)	Accounting Heads of Departments/Chief Executives drawing basic salary of Rs 32,470 and who benefit from the exclusive use of a self-driven Government vehicle	Rs 2,820

(a)	Travelling Allowance (car) Commuted Allowance	Rs 6,030 Rs 3,420
(b)	Travel Grant Commuted Allowance	Rs 4,060 Rs 2,350
