Setting up of Ethical Standards Management Committee

Please refer to this Ministry's Circular Note No. 9 of 20 October 2005, which highlighted the importance and advisability of setting up of an Ethical Standards Management Committee in each Ministry/Department as a means to promote the values advocated by the Code of Ethics for public officers.

It is to be pointed out that the Ethical Standards Management Committee should be under the responsibility of the Head of the Organisation and comprise a minimum of two other Senior Public Officers as well as a Trade Union representative. As indicated in its Terms of Reference, this Committee is therefore of utmost importance to foster good governance and ensure a high standard of conduct of public officers.

It would be appreciated if you would inform this Ministry by Friday 24 March 2006, of action taken at the level of your Ministry/Department on the implementation of this measure.
