Follow up action on Criminal Cases in which Public Employees are involved

The attention of this Ministry has been drawn by the Prime Minister's Office to a criminal case where appropriate departmental action had not been taken against an employee who had been convicted in relation to a drug-related offence as the Police Department had failed to report the outcome of the case to the Responsible Officer.

2. With a view to avoiding such recurrence, you are requested to ensure that there is regular follow-up with the Police Department regarding criminal cases where employees of your Ministry/Department are involved.
