Redeployment of employees of ex Service Providing Institutions of the Sugar Industry

In the context of the re-organisation of the former Service Providing Institutions (SPIs) of the Sugar Industry into the Mauritius Cane Industry Authority (MCIA), Government has decided that employees of the former SPIs be redeployed to Ministries/Departments or parastatal organisations. The Ministry of Finance and Economic Development (MOFED) has in its Circular Letter No. 11 of 2012 highlighted *inter-alia* that optimum use should be made of human resources including redeployment of excess and under employed human resources from within the public sector.

- Supervising Officers of Ministries/Departments will be provided with the list of employees who will be redeployed to their respective Ministries/Departments and/or those earmarked for redeployment to their parastatal organisations.
- Salaries should be met against funded vacancies but where this is not the case, this Ministry should be informed accordingly. It is understood that necessary arrangements would be made at your end to absorb these employees on your establishment as from the financial year 2013 upon creation or restyling of appropriate posts.
